If you are a new "lady" parishioner or just looking for a way to make new friends and become involved in our parish – then accept this invitation from Our Lady's Guild to come check us out at our monthly meetings or weekly workshops!

The 100+ parish "ladies in blue" of Our Lady's Guild extend a warm invitation <u>to you</u> to join us and experience the joy of working with energetic, loyal, creative, Christian women for the benefit of our parish.

Monthly meetings are held the first Monday of every month September through May AND begin at 9 am with Social time. This is where you learn about Guild projects and meet our members. There's an attendance prize, 50/50 drawing, refreshments thanks to our Kitchen committee AND – we celebrate birthdays. Guests are always welcome!

Workshops are held on 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 4^{th} Wednesdays monthly, from 9-11 am in Madonna Hall, January through October. Ladies are there making hand-crafted greeting cards, creating craft items, and evaluating jewelry and other donations for the annual October Craft Bazaar. They are also there working on other Guild projects. There's always coffee and refreshments. You don't have to be creative to be of help. All funds raised go to benefit our parish.

The Guild ladies also enjoy special luncheons and potlucks, travel trips and informative speakers. This year we will learn about "Scams and Frauds", "Sounds of Autism" and the "Mental Health Ministries" at our parish. There is a Book Club, a Welcome Committee, a monthly prayer list for sick members, a Sunshine Lady, Publicity and Membership Committees, and the Guild hosts Bernadette's Brew once each month.

The Guild was founded in July 1979 with just 30 ladies. During the 45 years of its existence, the Guild has donated over \$500,000. to help pay off various parish mortgages, purchase the stained-glass Rosary window above our altar, nativity scenes for both Churches, the flag pole, many icons, priest vestments, patio tables and umbrellas, sound system equipment, and more.
