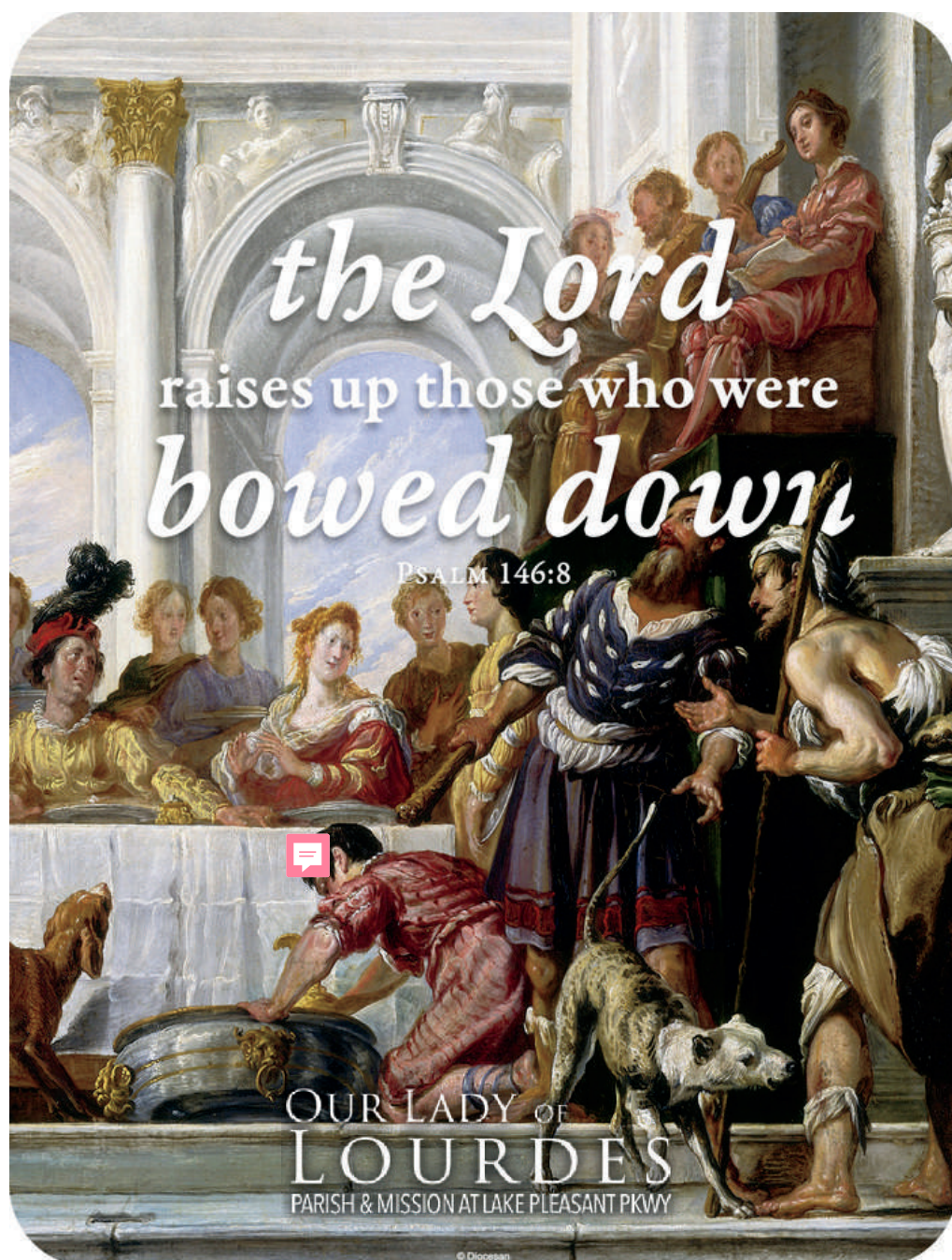

Respect Life: “Did you know?”

“Every human life, from the moment of conception until death, is sacred because the human person has been willed for its own sake in the image and likeness of the living and holy God.”

From the Catechism of the Catholic Church, Part 3, Line 2319

Did you know that there is a “Respect Life Ministry” established at Our Lady of Lourdes Parish and Mission at Lake Pleasant Parkway? The ministry meets the first Tuesday of every month. Gathering begins at 1:00 pm with a pro-life rosary prayed in the church. The general meeting starts at 1:30 pm in the Fr. McGivney Room.

Did you know that the Respect Life Ministry promotes advocacy and support for persons, institutions and community education around issues that degrade human life? Issues that degrade human life include abortion, assisted suicide, euthanasia, unethical research and medical practices and incarceration. Advocacy and education include prayer at abortion facilities and church, sharing information and community resources available to expecting parents that promote continuation of pregnancy up to birth and thereafter, and sharing information and community resources available to the elderly related to aging and natural end of life. A program designed to uplift the incarcerated via mail correspondence is currently being developed.

Did you know current activity undertaken by the ministry is the monthly baby item collection for the three diocesan approved pregnancy centers? Checks and cash collected via the “yellow envelopes” on the fourth weekend of the month is divided annually among the pregnancy centers at fiscal year-end. Checks were issued in the amount of \$5127.00 to each center in late July 2025. Annual “Baby Bottle Drives” are supported by the ministry. Several ministry members regularly pray outside the local Planned Parenthood facility in Glendale. A “Spiritual Adoption” program was developed in 2022 and continues to this date. Spring and Fall “Rosary Rallies” were initiated by ministry followers. The ministry also supports parish sponsored events relating to aging and end-of-life topics.

Did you know parishioners are welcome to attend monthly meetings? (Please note that active participation in any other ministry events requires annual Safe Environment Training (SET) compliance). Please direct any questions to Terese Boas at boasfmly@comcast.net.

Lastly, Aid to Women Center would like to extend their sincere thanks to the parishioners for the donations collected the weekend of August 23rd & 24th, 2025. August monetary donations totaled \$1400.00 and \$65.00 in direct donations.

The Feast Day of St. Vincent de Paul, September 27, 2025

The Feast of Saint Vincent de Paul honors a priest whose life reshaped the Church's mission of service. Born in 1581 in France, Vincent devoted himself to the poor, the sick, and the forgotten. He was ordained in 1600 and quickly recognized the deep spiritual and material poverty in society. His response was practical and organized. He built networks of charity that still influence the Church today.

Vincent founded the Congregation of the Mission, known as the Vincentians. Their task was to preach and serve in rural areas where people rarely saw a priest. He also established the Daughters of Charity with Saint Louise de Marillac. This community of women religious took vows but lived and worked outside of convent walls. They cared for the sick in hospitals, taught children, and helped the poor in their homes. His vision of service extended to prisoners and abandoned children, groups often ignored at the time.

The Church recognizes him as a saint because of his heroic virtue. His faith expressed itself through works of mercy, lived consistently over a lifetime. He practiced humility, sought justice, and placed the needs of the vulnerable first. He died in 1660 and was canonized in 1737. Pope Leo XIII later named him the patron of all charitable works. His example shows how holiness grows when faith and action meet.

Why is he important to the faith? Vincent demonstrated that love of God cannot remain abstract. It must be made visible in service to others. He trained priests to live disciplined, prayerful, and service-oriented lives. He promoted missions to strengthen the faith of rural communities. He shaped a model where charity was not left to individuals alone but was coordinated through institutions. Many Catholic hospitals, schools, and charitable organizations trace their spirit to him.

What can we learn from him?

- Service must be active and organized. Good intentions are not enough.
- Faith calls you to see Christ in the poor, the sick, and the forgotten.
- True leadership is humble and grounded in daily work.
- Renewal in the Church begins with prayer and practical action.
- Generosity grows when people work together rather than alone.

The feast of Saint Vincent de Paul is not only about honoring a historical figure. It calls you to reflect on how you serve those around you. His life shows that holiness is not distant. It is lived through concrete acts of charity. By acting with faith and compassion, you continue his mission in your own community.

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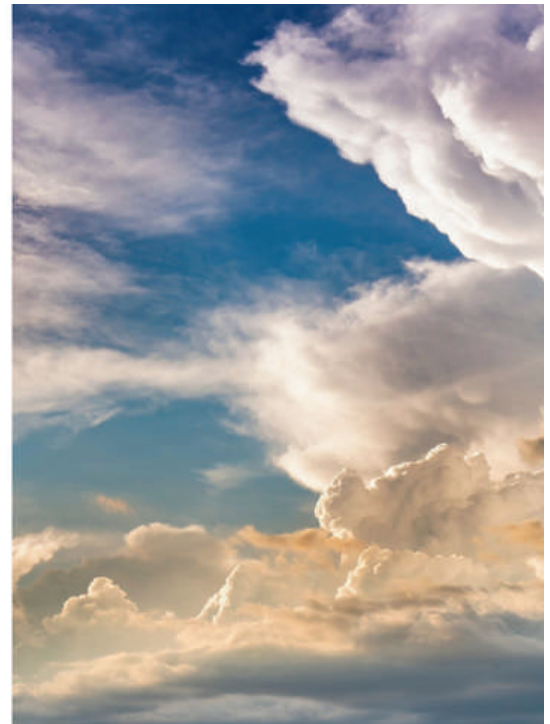

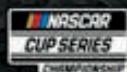

These prayers take approx. 15 min; no need to sign up, just come in and join us. We have prayer booklets to follow.

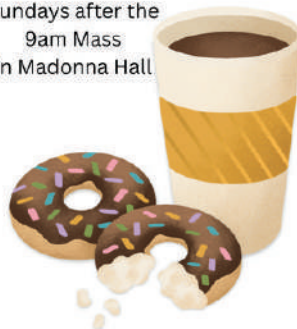
