Living with Integrity: Stewardship of the Heart

“I have come not to abolish but to fulfill.

Therefore, whoever obeys and teaches these commandments will be called greatest in the kingdom of heaven.”

Jesus calls His disciples to a righteousness that goes beyond outward observance and reaches the heart. This Gospel reminds us that stewardship is not only about what we give, but how we live—with integrity, honesty, and love. Our time, talents, and treasure are truly offered to God when they flow from reconciled relationships and sincere hearts. When we strive to live the commandments faithfully, our daily choices become a witness to God’s transforming grace. Stewardship, then, is a wholehearted response to Christ’s invitation to live the Gospel fully and authentically.

Petition:

That we may be faithful stewards of our hearts and lives, seeking reconciliation, living with integrity, and offering our time, talents, and treasure to God with sincerity, let us pray to the Lord.

Stewardship: Grace In Action

This week, examine how your daily choices reflect your commitment to Christ’s teachings. Is God inviting you to seek reconciliation, to speak more truthfully, or to live with greater integrity in your relationships and responsibilities? Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you, and take one concrete step to align your actions more closely with the Gospel.

As faithful stewards, may our lives reflect a “yes” that truly means yes to God.

- In what areas of my life is God calling me to a deeper, more authentic commitment to the Gospel?
- How can reconciliation and honesty strengthen my stewardship of time, talents, and treasure?
- What practical step can I take this week to live with greater integrity as a disciple of Christ?
