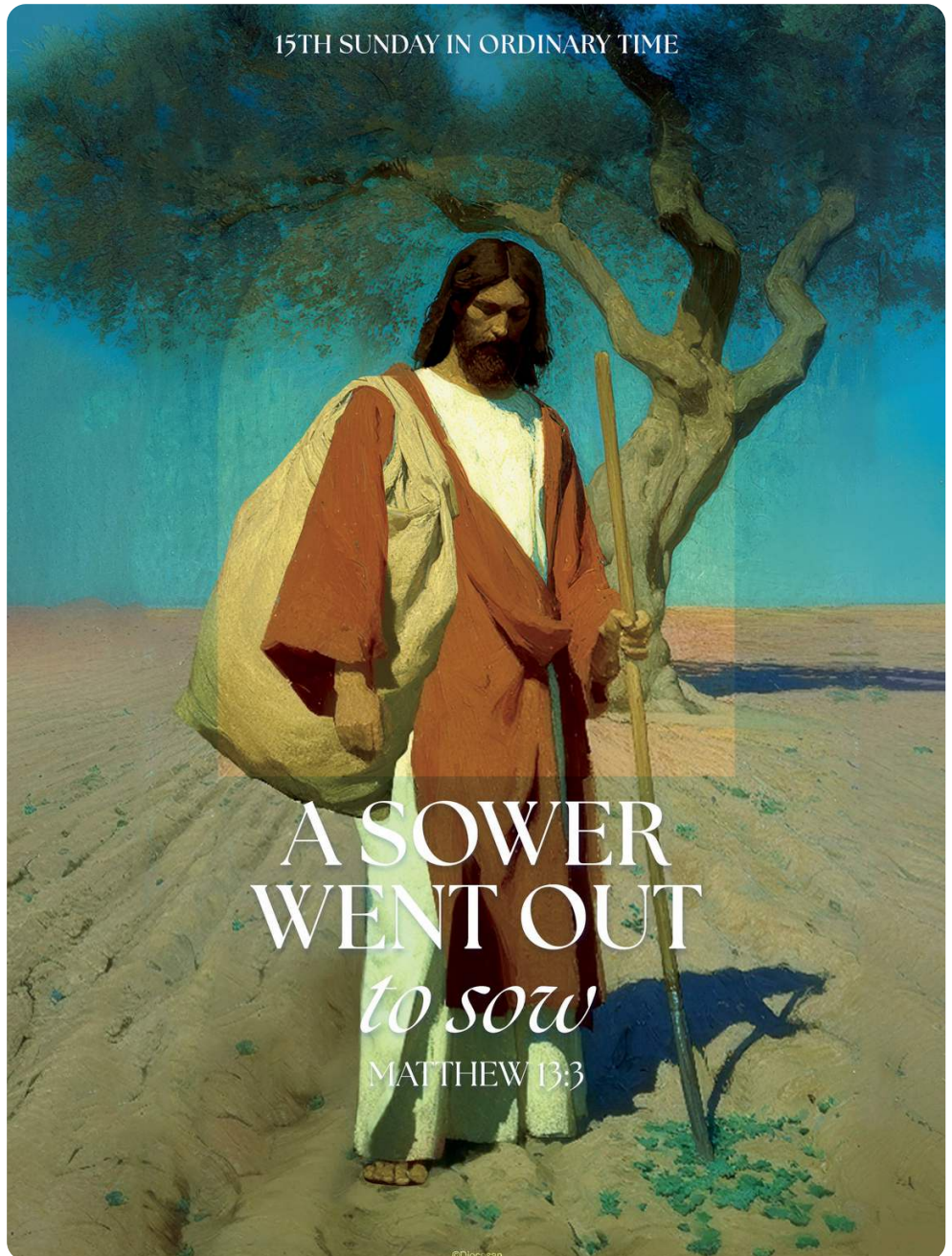

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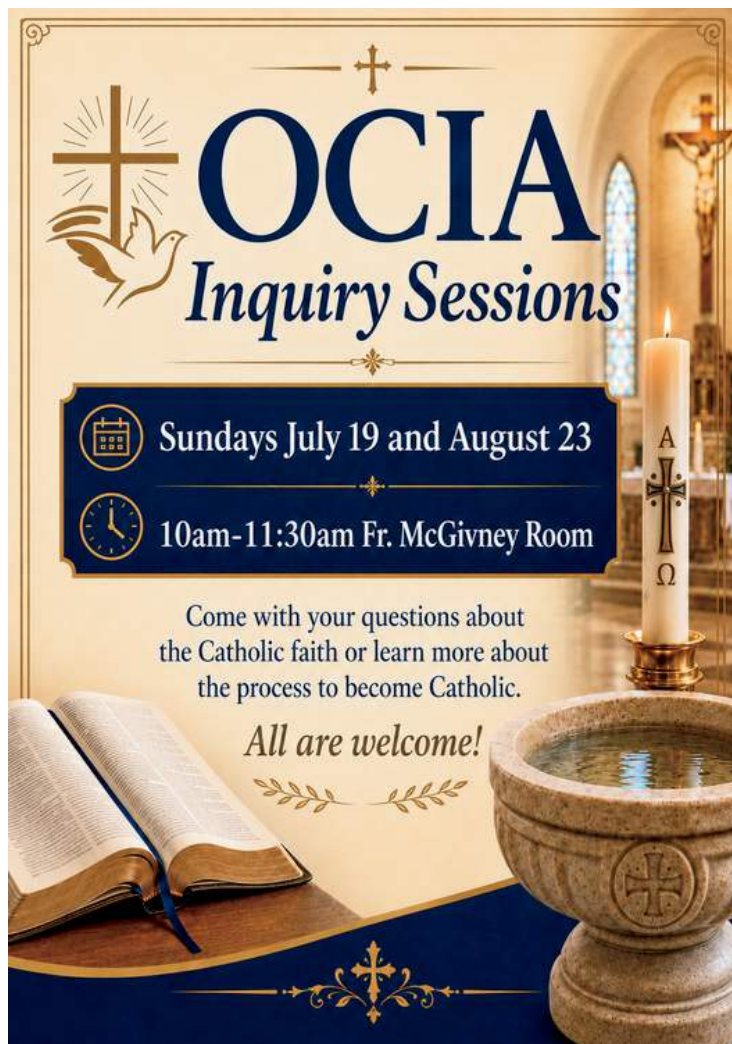
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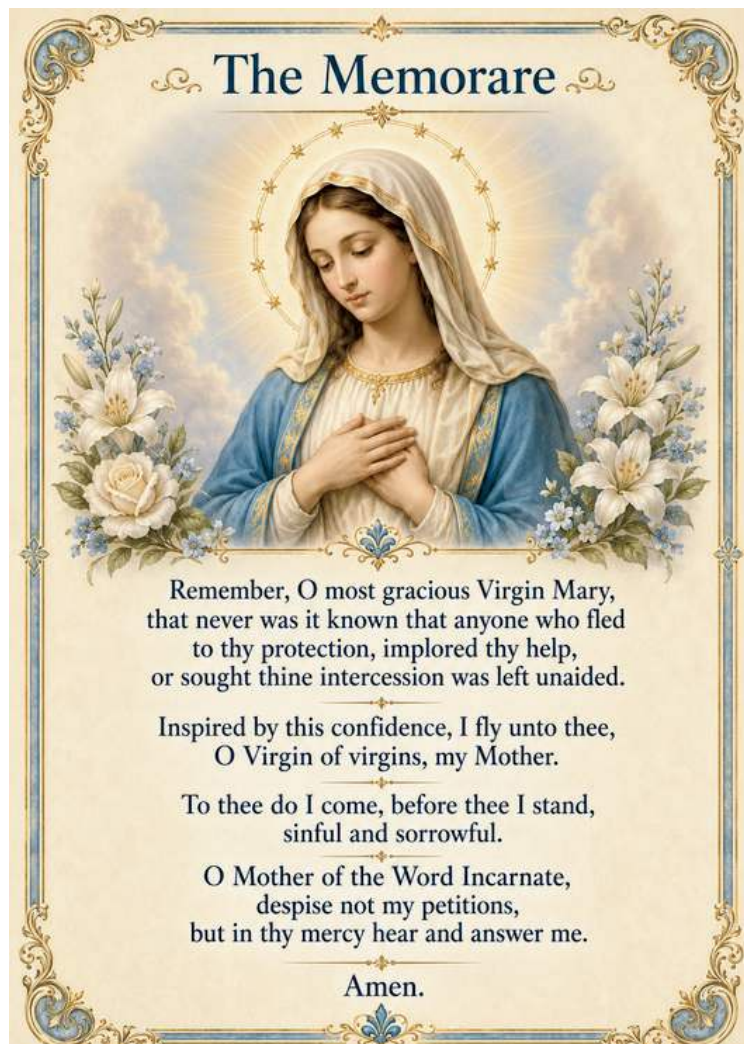

10 • THE SEEDS WE PLANT BECOME THE FUTURE WE LEAVE BEHIND



A farmer walks through his field at dawn, scattering seed across the ground. He does not know which seeds will take root and which will fall on rocky soil or among thorns. He plants anyway, with trust and patience, believing the harvest will come in time.

Jesus told this parable to describe how God's Word works within us. The seed is the Word. The soil is the condition of our hearts. Some hearts stay hardened, closed to grace. Some soften for a season, then wither under pressure. Some hearts stay shallow, distracted by worry and comfort. And some hearts receive the Word deeply, producing fruit thirty, sixty, a hundredfold.

God plants quietly. He does not force growth. He waits, and He works within us long before we notice change. Faith grows this way too. Every act of kindness, every moment of forgiveness, every prayer offered in silence becomes a seed placed into the soil of our lives and the lives around us.

This week we mark Independence Day and look ahead to America's 250th anniversary. The Treaty of Paris, signed in 1783, ended the Revolutionary War and secured the young nation's independence. The treaty opens with these words: "In the name of the most holy and undivided Trinity." Leaders of the founding generation placed God before matters of state, land, and governance. They understood a nation stands on more than laws and borders. A nation stands on the hearts of the people within her.

Laws matter. Institutions matter. But no law forces a heart toward love, mercy, or sacrifice. Only grace does this work, seed by seed, generation by generation. The strength handed down to us came from parents, grandparents, and neighbors who planted faith and virtue without seeing the full harvest themselves.

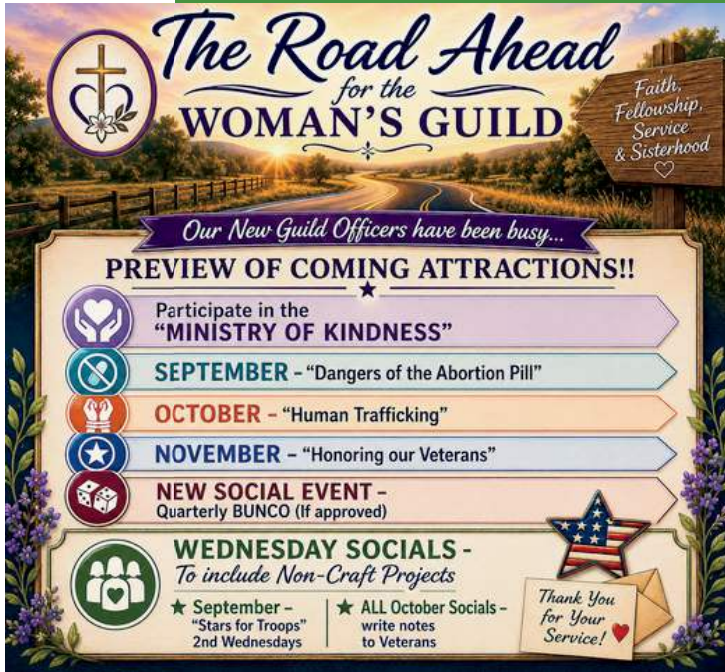
We face the same calling today. What seeds are we planting in our families? Are we sowing mercy, forgiveness, and love, or are we scattering seeds of resentment and division? Are we letting God's Word take root in our own hearts before we ask others to receive His Word?

The Sacred Heart of Jesus shows us what fertile soil looks like. A heart joined to Christ becomes soft, open, and warm toward others. When we bring our hearts to Him each day through prayer and the sacraments, He clears the rocks and pulls the thorns so His Word grows undisturbed within us.

Our legacy will not rest on wealth, titles, or accomplishments. Our legacy rests on the seeds of faith we plant in the people God places around us: our children, our neighbors, our parish family.

Prepare your heart as good soil this week. Trust the Lord with the planting, and trust Him with the harvest, in His time.

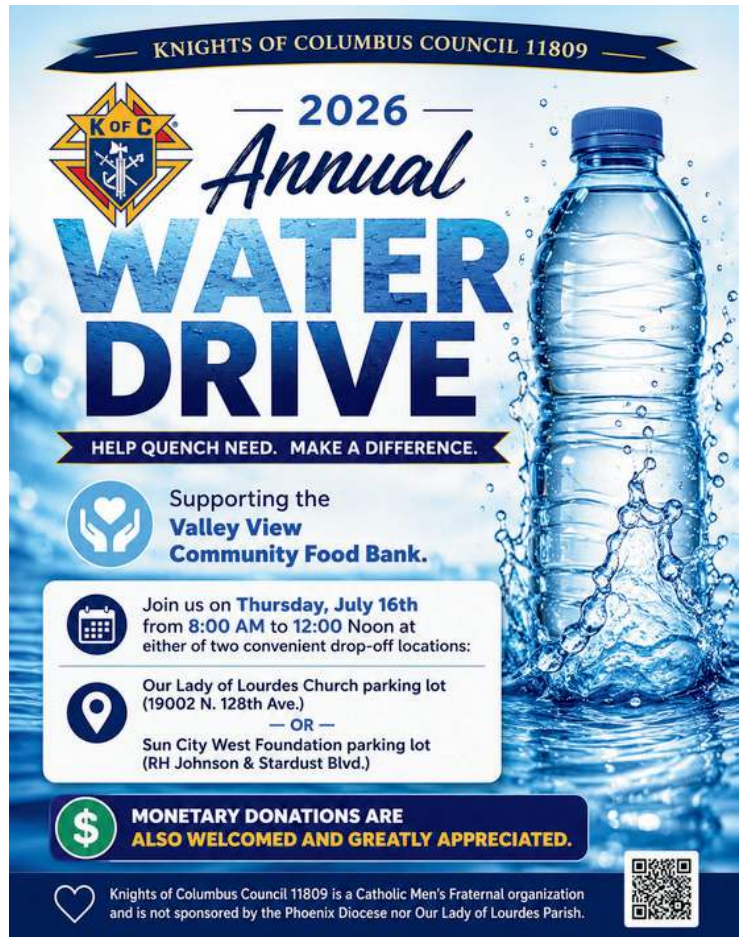

The Sacred Heart and Our Nation

This Sunday, Isaiah tells us God's word is like rain and snow. They fall from heaven and do not return without watering the earth first. They make the ground fertile and give seed to the sower and bread to the one who eats. God's word works the same way. It goes out and accomplishes what He sends it to do.

The Gospel gives us the Parable of the Sower. A farmer scatters seed on different ground. Some falls on the path and birds eat it. Some falls on rocky ground and withers fast. Some falls among thorns and gets choked out. Some falls on good soil and yields a harvest beyond measure.

You are the soil. Every day, God scatters His word into your life through Scripture, prayer, and the people around you. The question is not whether the seed is good. It is what kind of ground you offer it.

Ask yourself this week where your soil is rocky. Clear the ground. Let His word take root and grow.

SENT BY THE SACRED HEART

The Journey of St. Frances Xavier
Cabrini's Mission in America

Frances Xavier Cabrini left Italy in 1889. She trusted the Sacred Heart of Jesus and answered a call to serve. She wanted to work in China. Pope Leo XIII sent her west instead. She arrived in America, where Italian immigrants faced poverty and rejection.

Cabrini met real obstacles. She fought language barriers, low funds, and doubt from Church leaders. She kept going. She built schools, hospitals, and orphanages across the country. She gave dignity to people society ignored. She saw each immigrant child, each sick patient, each orphan as a beloved child of God.

Her work shaped the Catholic Church in America. She built a Church for the poor. She welcomed newcomers and cared for the forgotten. In 1946, she became the first U.S. citizen canonized a saint. Her life built faith across a nation.

Her story teaches a simple lesson. Holiness grows through daily action, not grand moments. Small acts of charity, repeated over years, change lives.

You do not need to build a hospital or cross an ocean to serve. Live her example today. Notice who around you struggles or feels forgotten. Offer a kind word or a helping hand. Serve your family, your parish, and your neighbors with courage. Trust God with your own calling.

Follow Cabrini's example. Trust God. Serve others. Carry Christ's love wherever you go.

DID YOU KNOW?

As a child, St. Frances Xavier Cabrini was considered too fragile and unhealthy to become a missionary. She was even rejected by religious communities because of her poor health.

Yet, by trusting in God's plan, she went on to cross the ocean more than 20 times and became one of the greatest missionaries in Catholic history.

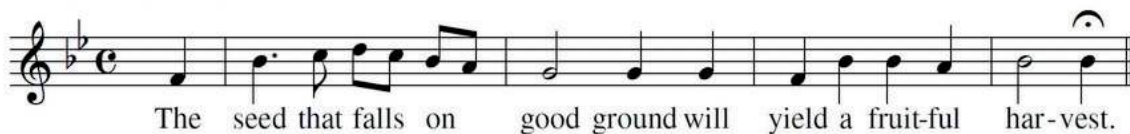

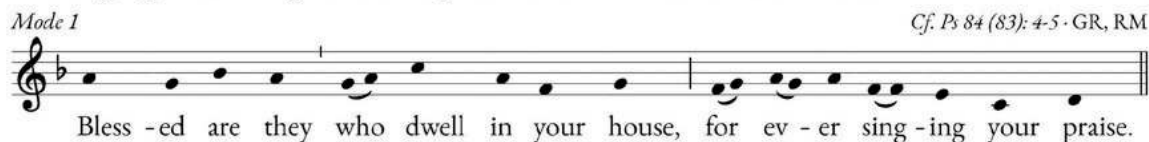

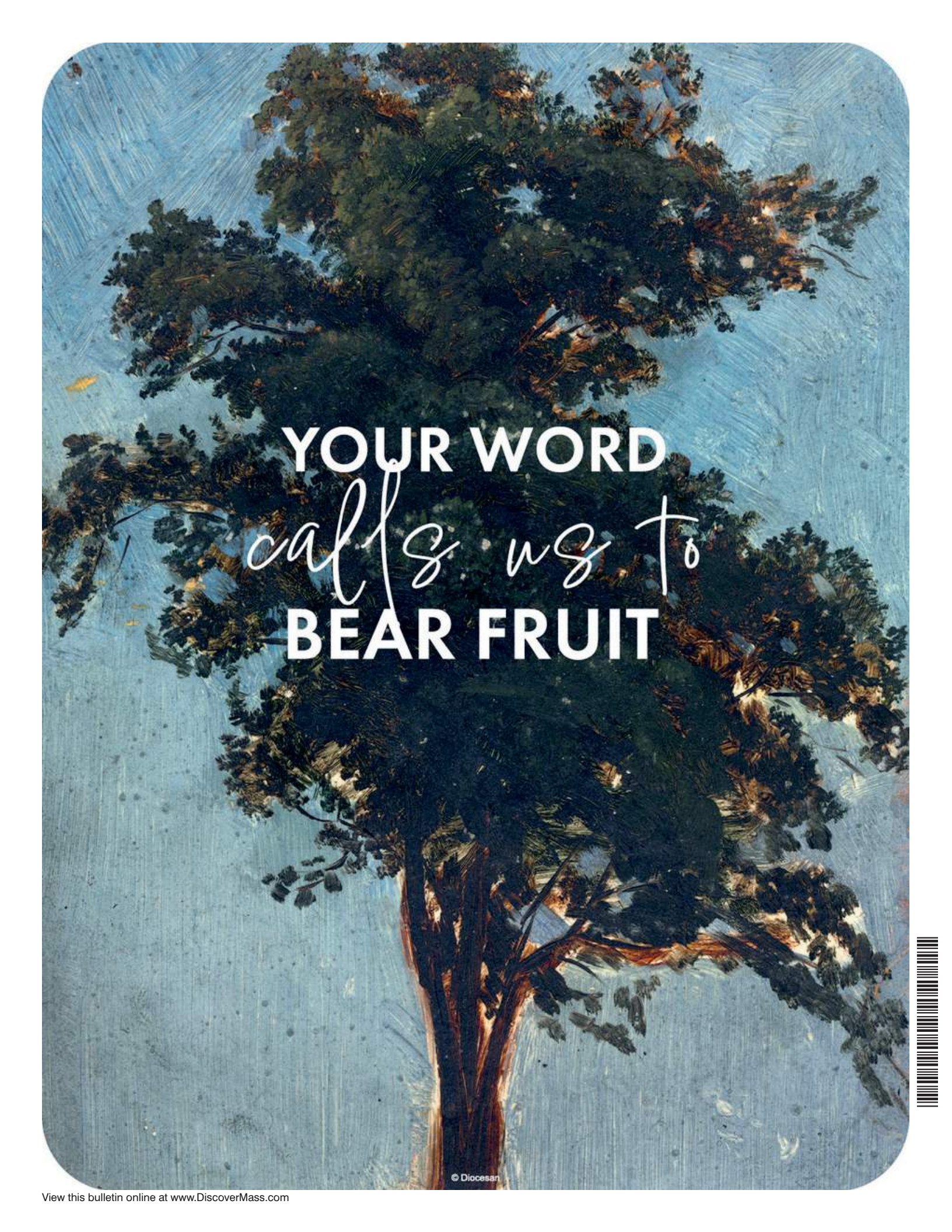
