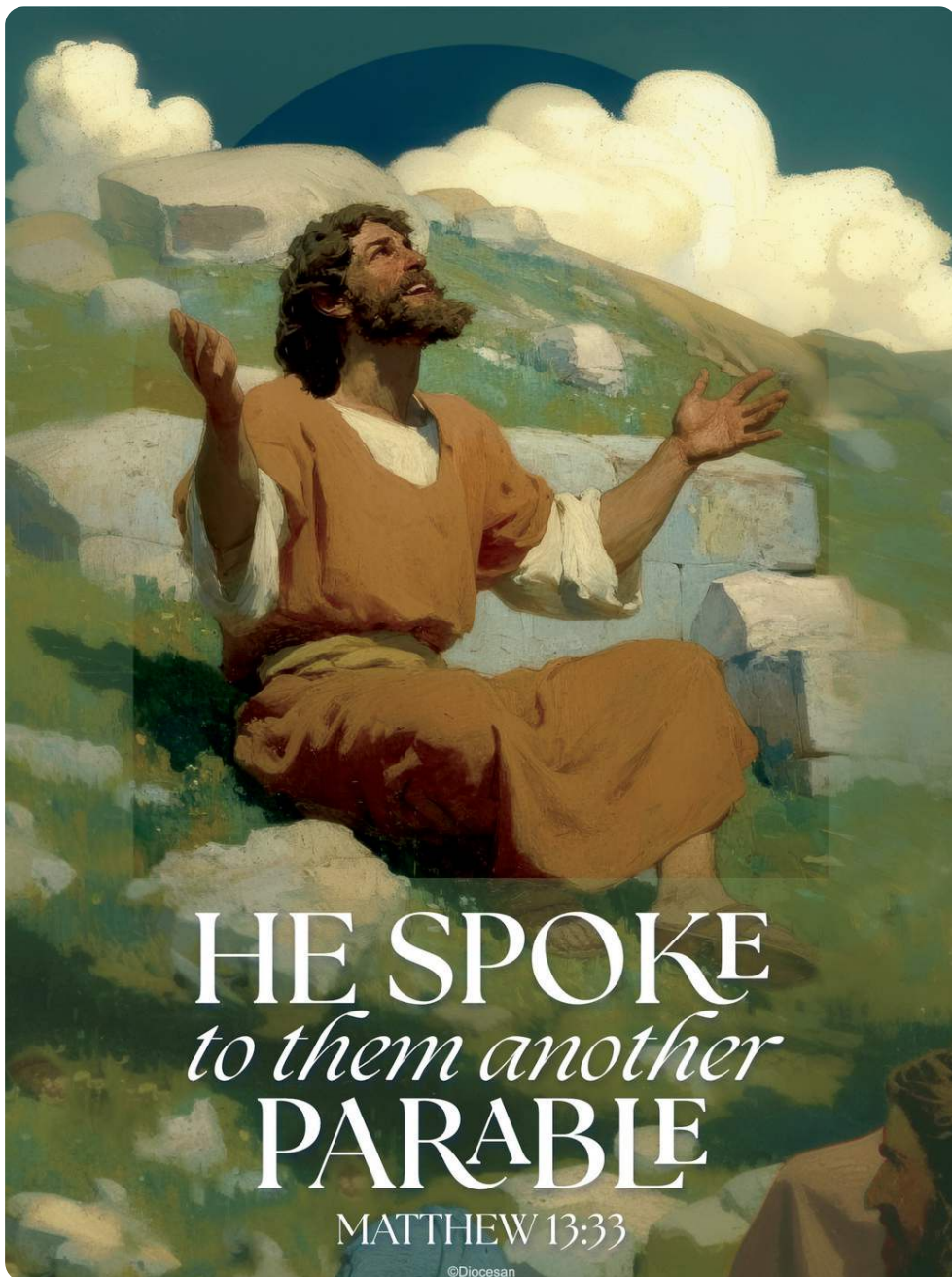

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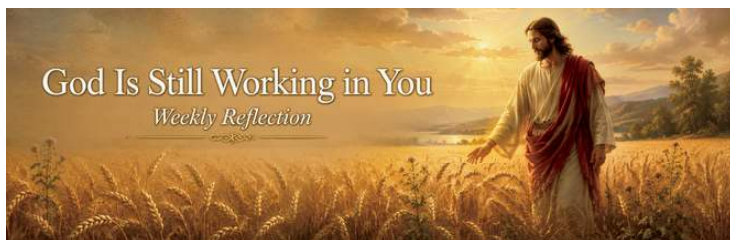
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Your Will**  
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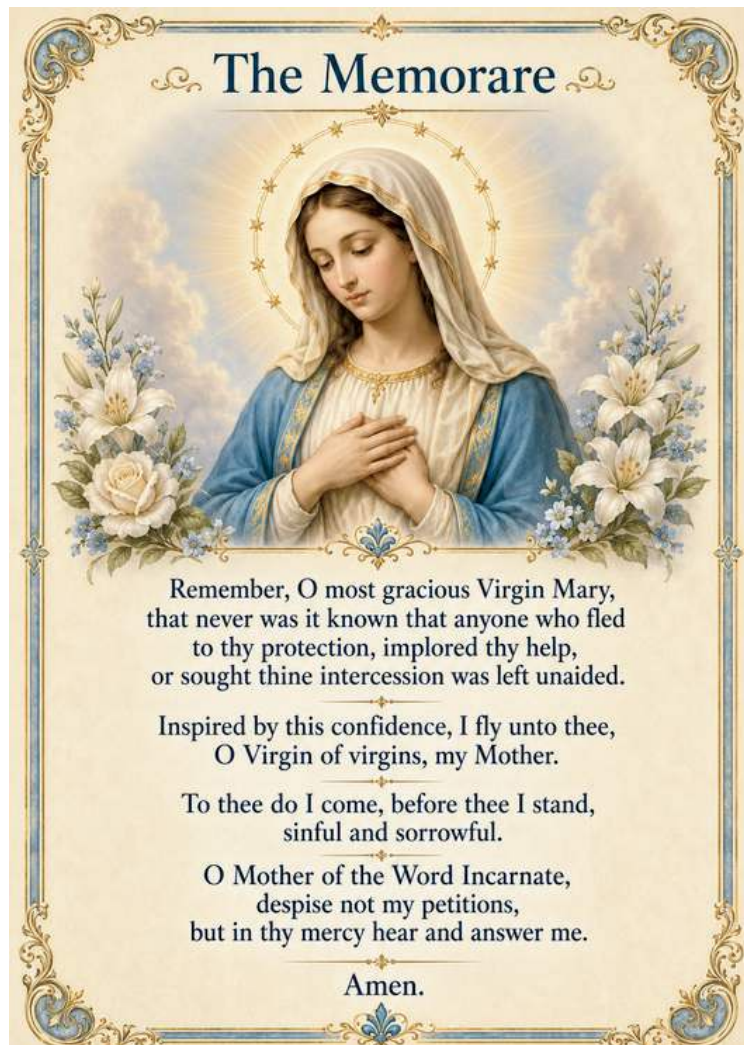
**The Parable of the Wheat and the Weeds** tells the story of a farmer whose field holds both wheat and weeds growing side by side. The workers want to pull the weeds right away. The farmer tells them to wait. He knows a hasty hand might tear out good wheat along with the bad.

We often ask why weeds exist in the world at all. This week, try a different question. Ask why God continues to work in you, even with the weeds still present in your own heart.

God has not walked away from His work in you. He tends the good growing in you with patience. At the same time, He slowly uproots what does not belong. This takes time. It takes grace. It takes a willingness on our part to let Him work, even in the parts of us we would rather hide.

Every day gives us another chance to let that grace take hold. The Gardener has not given up on His field. He has not given up on you either.

Take a moment this week to ask God to show you where He is still working in your heart, and thank Him for His patience with you.



Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary, that never was it known that anyone who fled to thy protection, implored thy help, or sought thine intercession was left unaided.

Inspired by this confidence, I fly unto thee, O Virgin of virgins, my Mother.

To thee do I come, before thee I stand, sinful and sorrowful.

O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not my petitions, but in thy mercy hear and answer me.

## 07 • RESPECT LIFE: DID YOU KNOW?



### DID YOU KNOW

St. Gianna Beretta Molla was an Italian pediatrician and mother? She developed a fibroma in her uterus while pregnant with her fourth child. Molla refused an abortion and hysterectomy in order to preserve the child's life. She prioritized her child's life over her own and died one week after giving birth, on the morning of Easter Sunday, April 28, 1962.

#### St. Gianna, pray for us!

**Did you know** Life Choices Women's Clinic provides pregnancy support, moral healthcare and pro-life education to encourage women to choose life? The clinic supports women through pregnancy and beyond! Casa St. Gianna is a 4-bedroom home in a quiet North Phoenix neighborhood, providing women with a safe place to continue their pregnancies and to prepare for their futures. Sometimes life gets overwhelming, especially for a single mom with no family support and nowhere to turn for help. **Housing cost increases have been hardest on single mothers and women with small children.** As pro-life people of faith, we can help women to choose life AND to move forward confidently and safely into a stable future, starting at Casa St. Gianna.

### DID YOU KNOW

your generosity provides a safe, supportive, and loving home for pregnant women, mothers, and little ones in need? Your kind donations will help provide housing, support, and hope to those who need it most. There are many ongoing needs at Casa St. Gianna. Some of them including:

General housekeeping and cleaning products; charger cords for electronic devices; shower totes; hair dryer/diffuser; water bottles; water cooler/dispenser; pajamas (female larger/maternity sizes); outside toys for ages 2-5 years old; linens including 3 twin bed comforters, 1 queen size comforter, 3 pillows and sheets for twin beds; towel sets (each guest is given a set they can take with them when they leave); clothing including maternity, socks, new sport bras for larger sizes and new underwear in larger sizes; dishes, silverware and small kitchen appliances (NO sharp knives! These items are given to moms when they leave to stock their new apartments); Valley Metro Copper Cards; gift cards for groceries and shoes. Diapers, wipes and baby items go to the Life Choices Women's Clinic and are moved to the house as needed. Wipes and diaper sizes 3, 4, 5, & 6 are the most required items at the clinic.

## 10 • WHY GOD PERMITS THE WEEDS TO REMAIN



Every faithful heart has wondered this: Why does God permit evil to remain when He possesses the power to remove it in an instant? The question is not a symptom of weak faith. It is the honest cry of a soul that longs for goodness to triumph. Sacred Scripture answers not with a tidy explanation of suffering, but with an invitation to trust the patient heart of God.

In the Book of Wisdom, we encounter a striking revelation. There is no God besides the Lord, who cares providentially for all. The same passage declares that God governs with clemency and that His might becomes the source of justice. Here is the great reversal our logic often misses. God does not postpone judgment because He is powerless before evil. He postpones it because His power is expressed through mercy. Only One who reigns sovereign over all creation can afford such patience.

Christ makes this vivid in the parable of the wheat and the weeds. The servants wish to rush out and uproot every weed immediately. The master forbids it: "Let both grow together until the harvest, lest you uproot the wheat along with them." In this parable, the heart of God stands revealed. He does not desire the destruction of sinners. He desires their salvation. Every weed left standing today is a soul still within reach of transforming grace.

Consider the saints. None arrived at holiness in a single moment. Augustine wandered for years before his surrender. Peter denied Christ three times before becoming the unshakable rock of the Church. Every canonized saint once depended entirely upon God's patience toward his own frailty and sin. Had judgment arrived too soon, much of the calendar of saints would never have been written into glory.

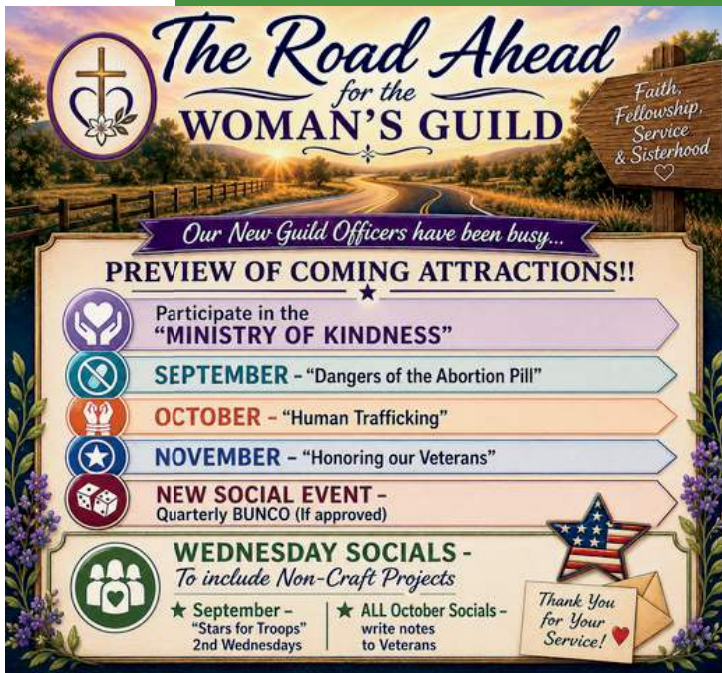
Saint Paul reminds us in Romans that we, too, remain unfinished. The Spirit Himself intercedes on our behalf with groanings too profound for words. Even now, in our imperfect condition, grace labors quietly within us, just as it once labored within every saint who came before us.

This truth should gently soften how we regard others. We rarely see the whole of a person's hidden story. Only God perceives the heart, and only He knows what His grace might yet accomplish within it. To judge too swiftly is to forget that we ourselves were once weeds awaiting mercy.

The presence of evil in this world is not proof that God has abandoned it. It is proof that He is still lovingly calling sinners home. Trust His timing. Let your own heart become good wheat and let it grow steadily toward the harvest—rooted deeply in patience, ripened slowly by grace, and destined for glory.

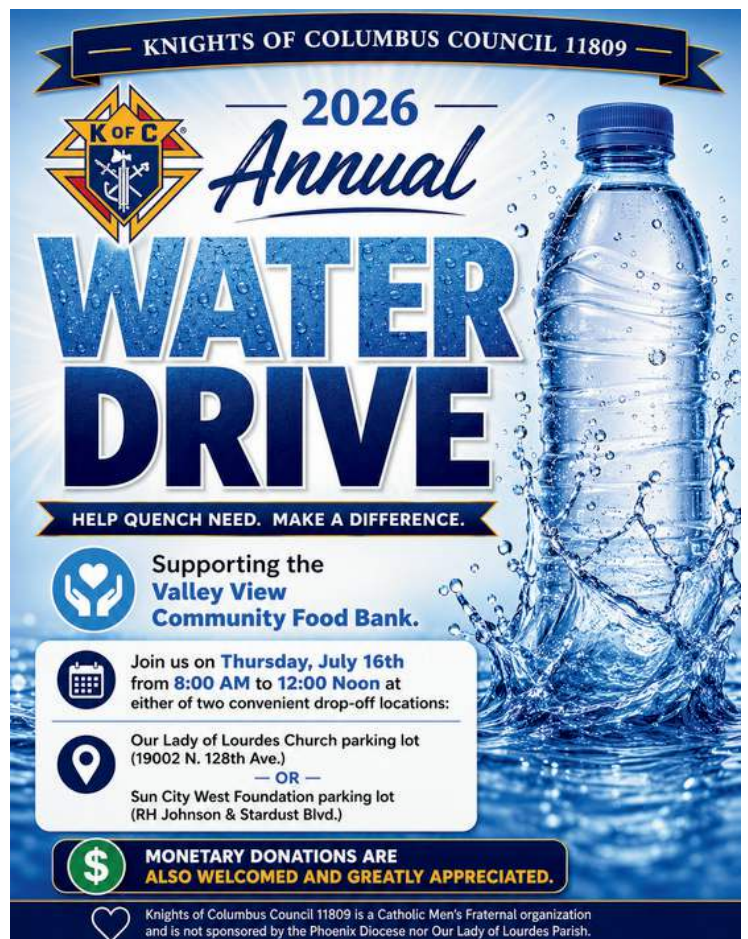

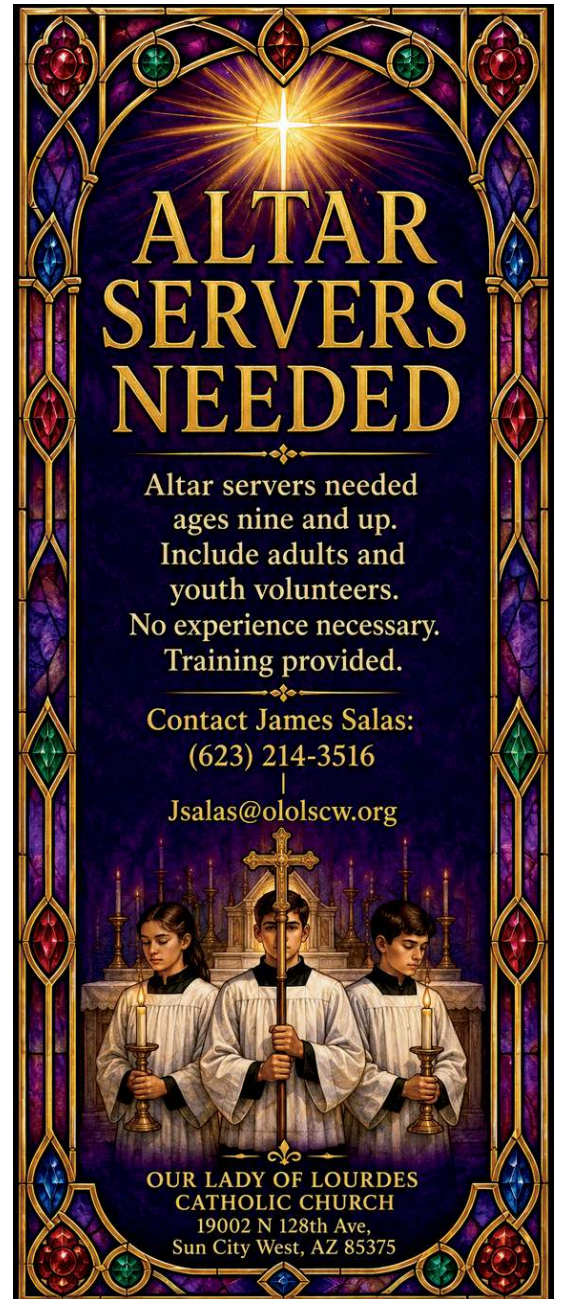

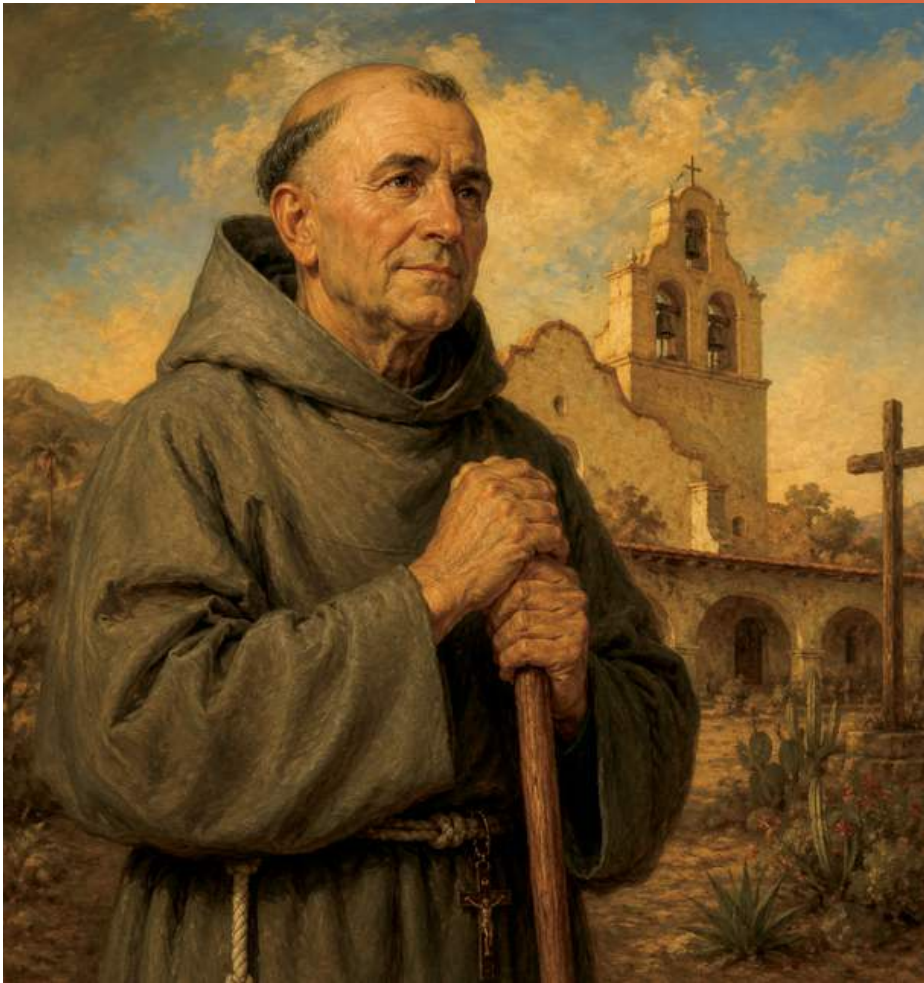

## 13 • SAINT OF THE WEEK



### ST. JUNIPERO SERRA: ALWAYS FORWARD

Nine missions, one bad leg, and a fight for justice

St. Junipero Serra gave up a comfortable career as a theology professor at age thirty-five to voyage to the New World. Arriving in Mexico in December of 1749, he decided to travel two hundred fifty miles to Mexico City rather than ride a mule. An insect bite rendered his leg badly infected, and it never completely recovered. He traveled in pain for the rest of his life. It never stopped him.

In 1769, at age fifty-five, he advanced north into Alta California and established nine missions over the next fifteen years, from San Diego to San Francisco. Those missions developed into major California cities, and El Camino Real still retraces the path he once walked.

Serra also advocated for the native peoples he served. In 1773, he traveled from Carmel to Mexico City, nearly dying twice, to report abuses by Spanish soldiers to the viceroy. He presented a document called the Representation, thirty-two articles calling for reform. The viceroy decided in his favor on thirty of the points. Pope St. John Paul II later described it as a bill of rights for native Americans.

Canonized in 2015 by Pope Francis, Serra was celebrated as a priest who protected the dignity of the native community. His motto, *siempre adelante*, always forward, still resonates with us today.

### Did You Know?

During the American Revolution, Spain entered the war against Britain, and St. Junipero Serra rallied the California missions to pray for an American victory. When the Spanish Crown levied a war tax, he paid it himself out of his own Mass stipends, and made sure the native peoples were never assessed for it.

In a real sense, the Father of California quietly supported the cause of American independence from the opposite coast, without ever setting foot in the thirteen colonies.

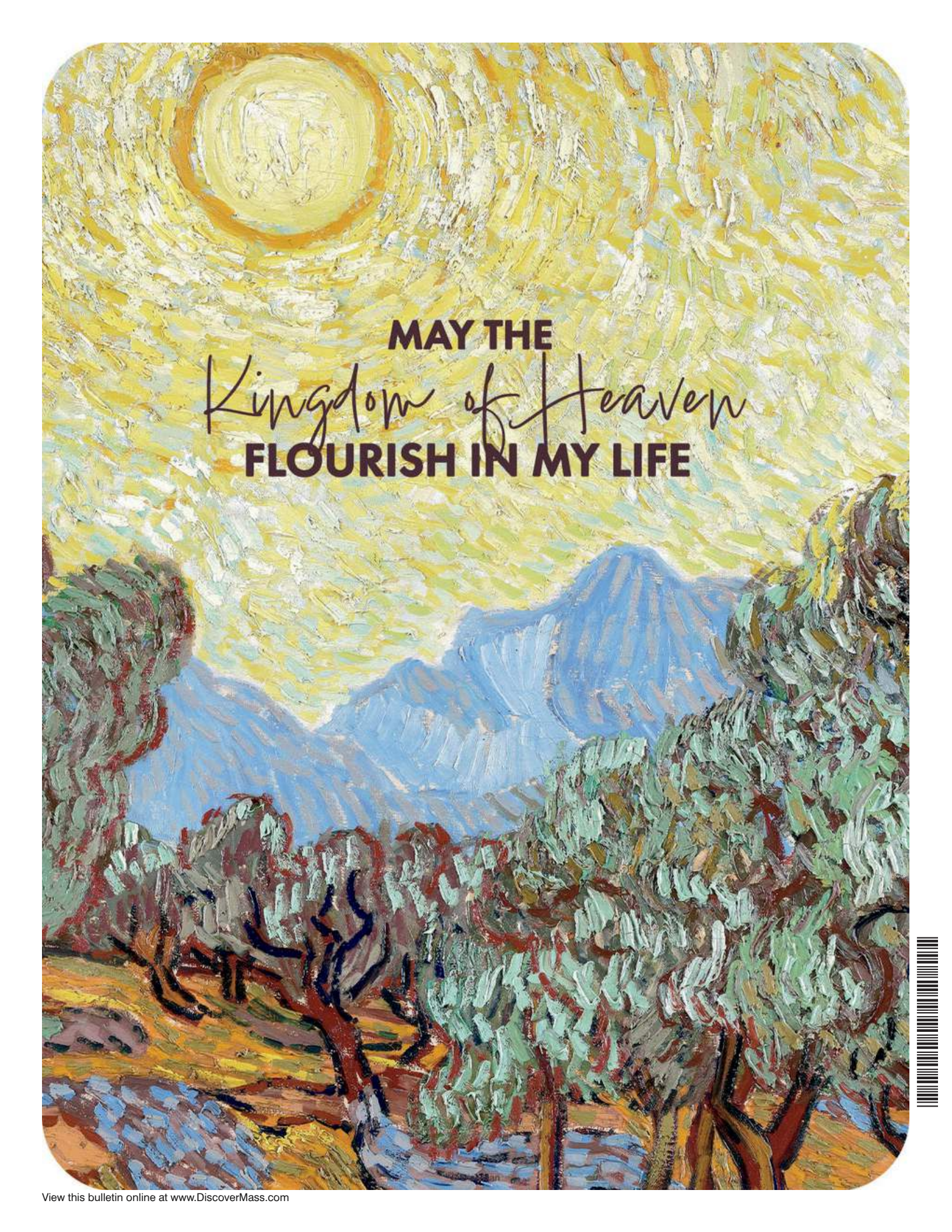
