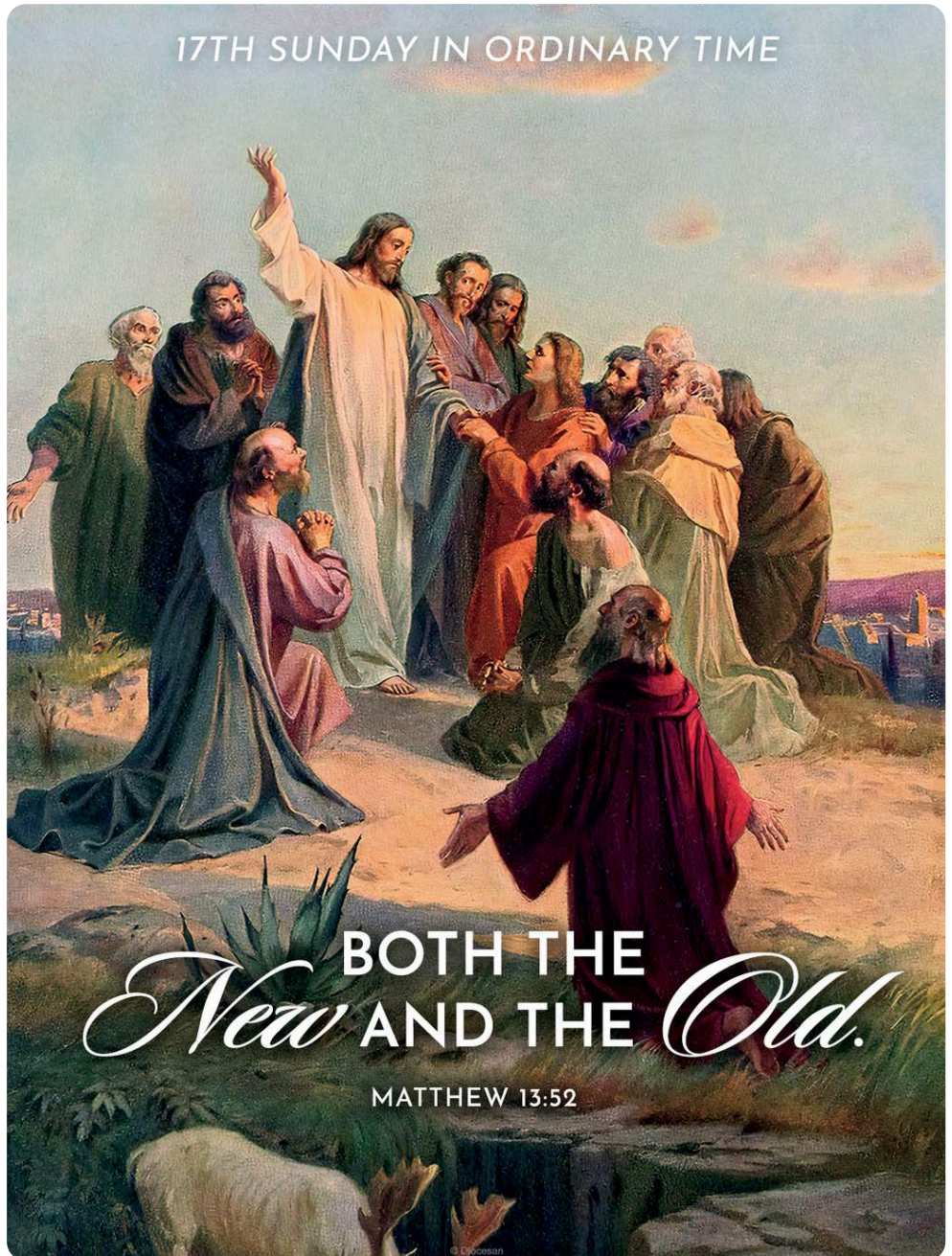

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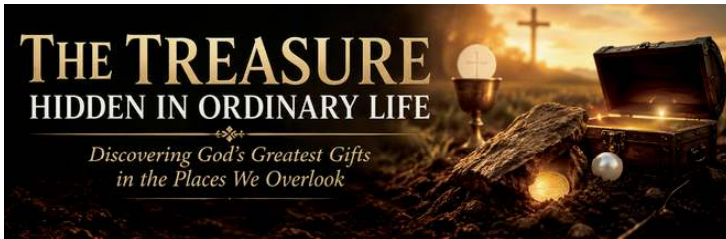
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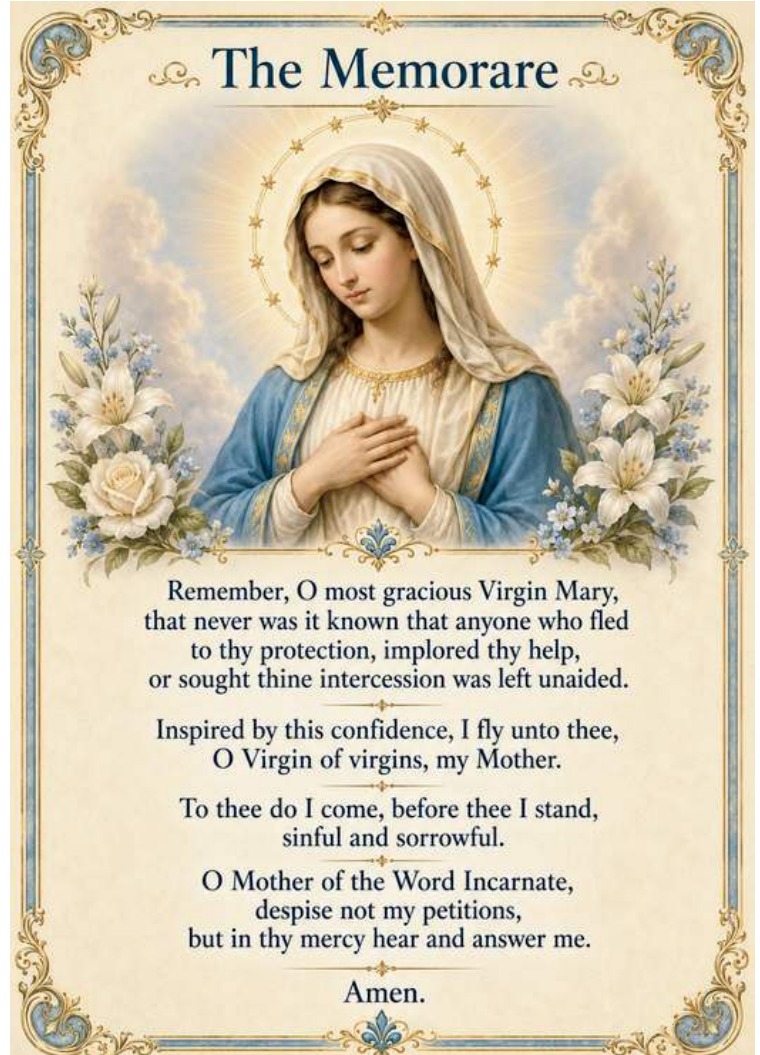
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Have you walked past treasure without knowing it was there? In Matthew 13:44–52, a man finds treasure hidden in a field. He sells everything to buy that field. Christ hides in plain sight too. He waits for you in ordinary places you pass every day.

Look at the Eucharist. You receive the body and blood of Jesus at Mass, yet the routine of Sunday can dull your wonder. Look at Confession. God offers full forgiveness in a small room, yet the line feels ordinary. Look at Adoration. Christ sits present before you in silence, yet the chapel stays empty. Look at your own family. God places love and grace in the people who sit across your dinner table, yet you rush past them each day.

Familiarity breeds blindness. The treasure never moved. Your eyes stopped searching. This week, choose one hidden gift and treat it as the treasure it is. Sit with the Eucharist a little longer. Walk into Confession before you feel ready. Spend ten quiet minutes before the tabernacle. Look your family members in the eyes and really listen. God did not hide his greatest gifts far away. He placed them right where you already stand. Go find your field.

These prayers take approx. 15 min; no need to sign up, just come in and join us. We have prayer booklets to follow.





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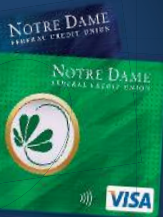
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09 • RECOGNIZING THE TREASURE, AND SHARING IT



A man walks past a field every day on his way to work. He never looks twice at the dirt beneath his boots. Then one afternoon, digging near an old fence line, he strikes something hard. Buried coins. Ancient pottery. A fortune hidden for generations under ground he had crossed a thousand times without noticing.

This is the world Jesus describes in Matthew 13:44–52. A treasure hidden in a field. A pearl of great price. Both parables turn on the same truth: something priceless sits close by, and most people walk past it without seeing.

The treasure Jesus describes is not gold or jewels. The treasure is Jesus himself. When a person truly encounters Christ, everything shifts. Priorities rearrange. Old comforts lose their grip. The man in the parable sells everything he owns, and Jesus tells us he does this from joy, not duty. Real faith grows from love, not fear.

Jesus closes this teaching with a picture of a scribe trained for the Kingdom, who brings from his storeroom both the new and the old. Every believer carries this same calling. We are asked to guard the treasure of our faith and offer it freshly to those around us. The Church has kept these truths whole for two thousand years while speaking them anew to each generation that needs to hear them.

Consider what treasures sit within reach every week. The Eucharist, God himself, present on our altars. Reconciliation, where sin loses its weight. The saints, who walked this same road before us. Daily prayer, a direct line to the Father. Acts of charity, small and unnoticed. The parish community gathered around you right now.

Ask yourself honestly. Do these still stir wonder in you, or has familiarity worn the edges smooth? A gift held too long without gratitude starts to feel ordinary. The treasure has not changed. Our eyes have grown tired.

Renew that sight. Return to Scripture with fresh attention. Kneel in prayer like it matters, because it does. Receive the sacraments as the priceless gifts they are, not routine stops in a busy week.

Then share what you have found. The Kingdom of God does not grow through grand gestures alone. It grows quietly, one heart at a time, whenever someone recognizes Christ through the patient witness of another believer. Your kindness, your honesty, your steady faith might be the very thing that helps someone else finally notice the treasure buried in plain sight.
