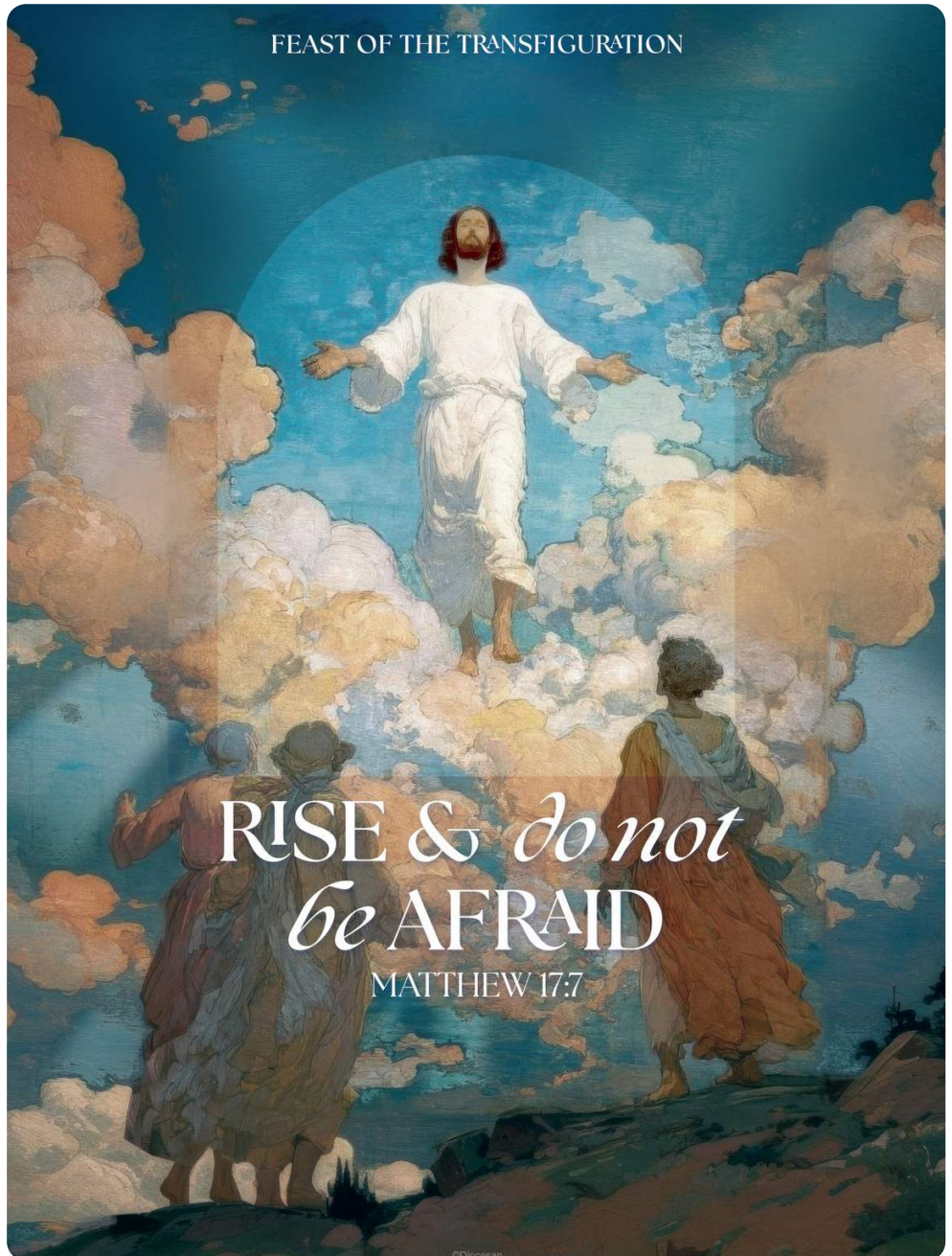

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Your Will**
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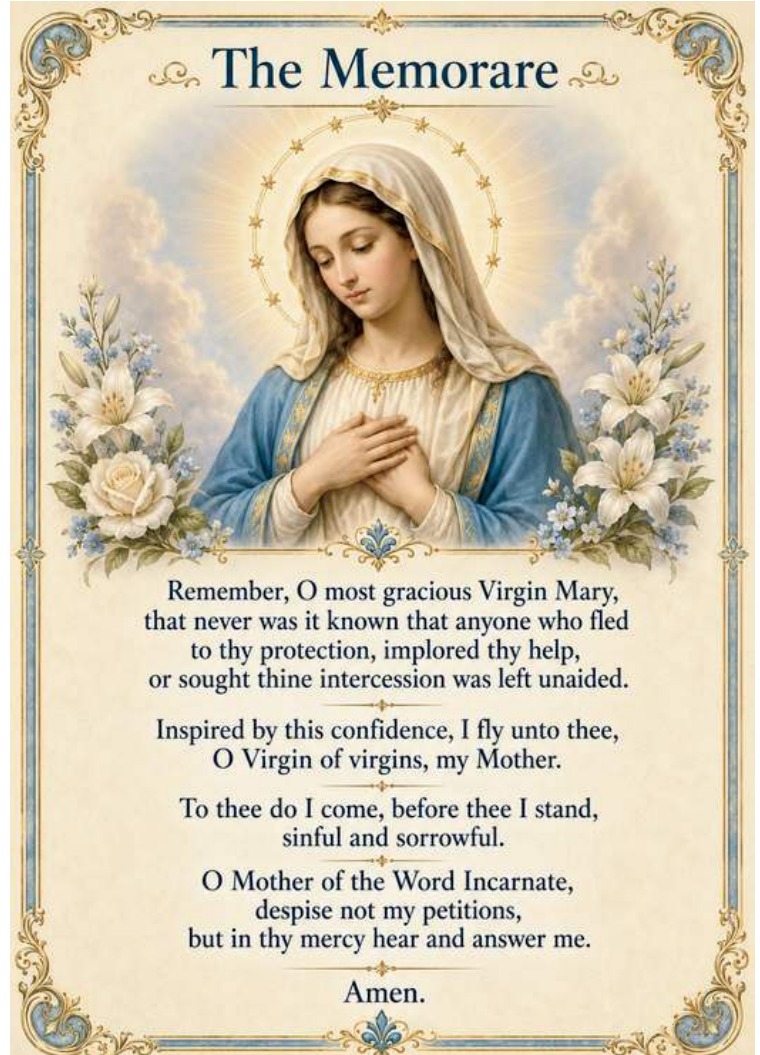
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The disciples looked at the crowd and saw a problem. Thousands of hungry people, and five loaves and two fish in hand. The math did not work. They wanted Jesus to send the people away. Jesus saw something different. He did not ask the disciples what they wished they had. He asked for what they already held. Five loaves. Two fish. That was enough for Him to work with.

Isaiah gives the same invitation. Come to the water, even if you have no money. Come and eat. God calls His people to trust His providence over their own resources. Psalm 145 confirms this truth. The Lord opens His hand and satisfies the needs of every living thing. Paul reminds us that nothing can separate us from the love of Christ. Not hardship, not distress, not any power on earth. The Lord who multiplied bread still multiplies every gift placed into His hands today.

This truth shapes parish life. You may feel you have little to offer. A few minutes of prayer. A kind word. A listening ear. An hour of service. These gifts feel small against the need around you. But Christ does not need much. He needs what you have. This week, ask a simple question. Lord, what have You already placed in my hands? Trust Him with the answer.

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09 • THE MIRACLE BEGINS WHEN WE STOP COUNTING



The disciples stand before thousands of hungry people. They do the math fast. Five loaves. Two fish. Thousands of mouths. The numbers do not work, so they ask Jesus to send the crowd away.

We do the same thing every day. We look at our schedules and see no room for prayer. We look at our savings and see no room for generosity. We look at our energy at the end of a long week and see no room for one more act of service. We count what we lack before we consider what Christ can do with what we have.

Isaiah offers a different starting point. Come to the water, even without money. Come, receive grain and eat without paying. God's generosity has never matched human logic. The world tells us to guard what little we hold. God tells us His grace does not run low when we share it.

Psalms 145 says the Lord opens His hand and satisfies the needs of every living thing. The multiplication of the loaves is not a rare exception to how God works. It is a clear picture of how God always works. Every sunrise, every harvest, every unearned mercy shows a God who delights in providing for His people.

Look again at the Gospel scene. Jesus does not ask the disciples for more than they have. He asks them to bring what they already hold. The miracle does not start when the crowd is fed. It starts the moment a small offering lands in the hands of Christ. God still works this way. An hour spent helping at the parish. A prayer said with real attention. A kind word to a stranger. An invitation to Mass extended to a neighbor. A grudge finally forgiven. These acts seem small on their own. Placed in Christ's hands, they reach further than we could plan.

Paul gives us the reason we can offer these gifts without holding back. Nothing can separate us from the love of Christ. Not hardship, not distress, not any force in this world. Because His love has no end, we never need to fear running dry by giving of ourselves. The Lord who multiplied bread on that hillside still multiplies every gift given in faith today.

Stop measuring your life by what you lack. Ask a better question instead. Lord, what have You already placed in my hands today? God has always done His greatest work through ordinary people who trusted Him with ordinary gifts. A widow's coins. A boy's lunch. A carpenter's hands. He is not waiting for you to have more. He is waiting for you to offer what you already carry.

Bring Him your five loaves and two fish this week, whatever form they take. Place them in His hands and watch what He does with them.

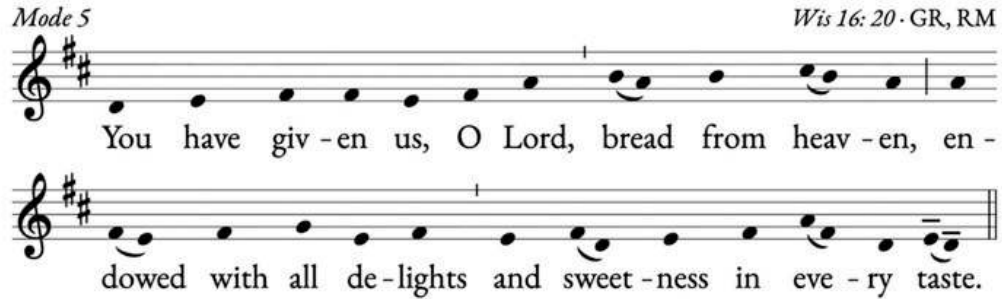

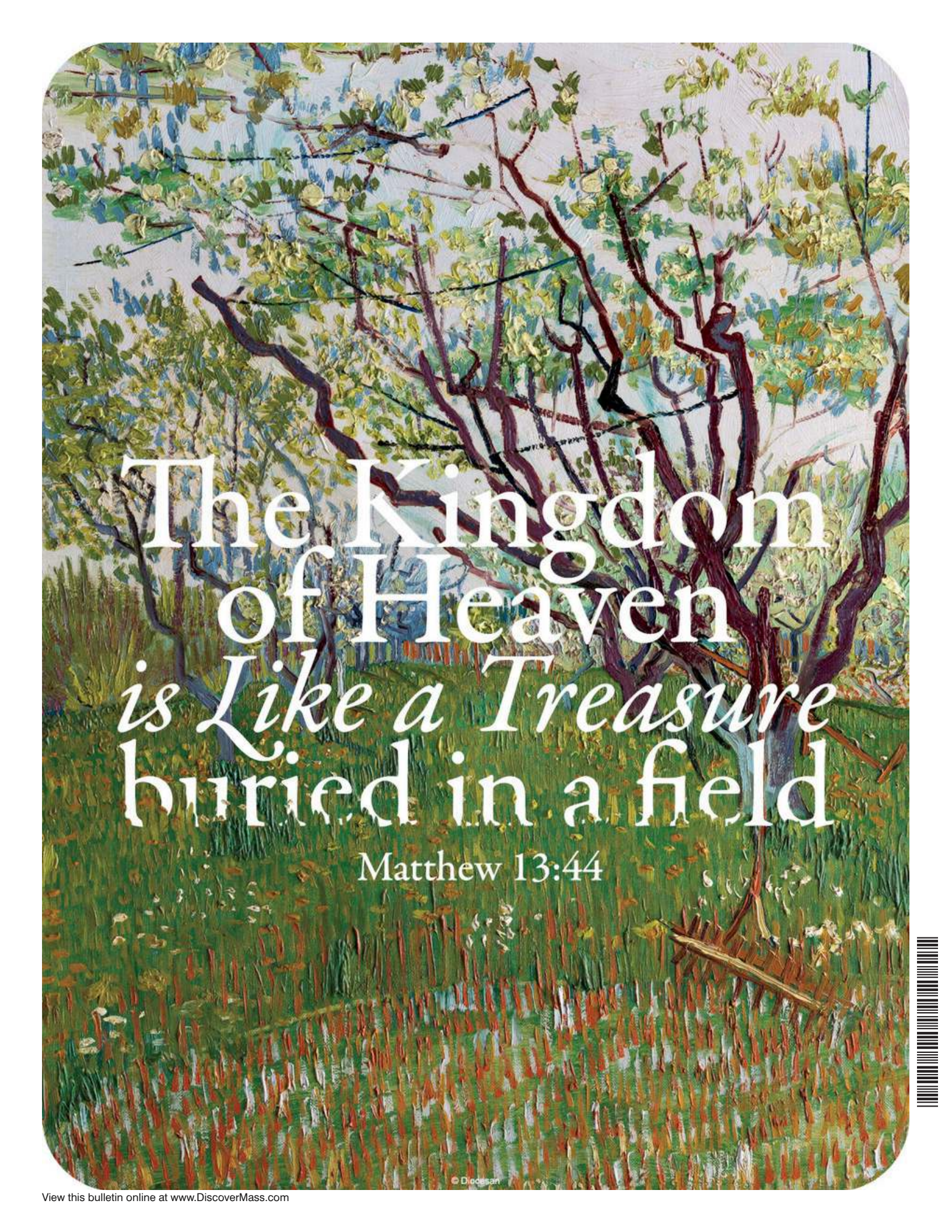
