BLAST FROM THE PAST

Our Lady's Guild has a rich history dating back to its founding in July 1979.

Did you know... that in 1995 Guild membership went above 500 for the first time? During that year the Women's Guild donated almost \$29,000 to the parish. Among the things those funds were used for - \$4,000 for vestments, \$3,900 fpr office furnishings, \$1,500 fpr a baptismal font, \$1,500 to refurbish the Lourdes church dome, and \$1,000 fpr items needed to say Masses at the Palm Ridge Rec Center. In 1996 the Guild gave \$9,500 to the parish to purchase a 14 piece Nativity set.

Prince of Peace Church was dedicated in April 1999. Thereafter the Women's Guild began alternating its monthly meetings between the two church halls. Wednesday workshops were held in St. Michael's Hall at Prince of Peace. The annual Guild bazaar was held there as well since it was a much larger Hall. This continued until 2019 when Father David Ostler abruptly disbanded the Guild. In 2021, when the two churches became separate parishes, Our Lady's Guild was formed for each parish.
